The bike was an open frame YB100 Yamaha, rich blue with a top box for my helmet. (Also held the week's groceries) Not a big bike, but all I could afford and brand new.

And the best bit? 50p worth of petrol lasted a fortnight! A bit more if we visited the olds at the weekend or went exploring.

Hubby bought a 250 MZ. A Czechoslovakian workhorse that NEVER broke down but an absolute sod to start.

I only tried to take it out once on my own. 'Please start, you bastard of a thing'. Twenty minutes later, sweating like the proverbial, having removed seventeen layers of clothes, at least, with my right leg a quivering, 'boneless' appendage, I had to admit defeat. I hoped to God none of the neighbours were watching.

I didn't go out, at all, that day.

My blue Yammy was a little beauty. Reliable transport to work, held all the shopping, (albeit with a box of cereal or washing powder stuffed down my jacket), honed my biking skills and gave several years of fun and adventure. Wonder where it is now.....
