

2. You must attend at least 3 meetings and help at awareness days or functions. At this stage a Full Member will become your sponsor. You will become an Associate member and you can stay an Associate or stay as a supporter as long as you like. These two categories cannot work directly with Children or represent M.A.C.E. without a full member being present
3. To become a full member will take a minimum of (12) twelve months. This period is so as you can learn our policies , procedures and rules of engagement with children.

There are two ways.

- (1) you own or have access to a motorbike capable of highway speeds



FRASER COAST TOY RUN 2021

ROUTE IN BRIEF

Enter by the top/northern end of the Brolga Theatre carpark, we will exit from the lower or southern end.

Departing 9am led by Old Rural Fire Service, (yet to be confirmed), with santa on the trike and escorted by Diggers Military MC Fraser Coast, Independent Riders and MACE Wide Bay. Cars and trucks to follow after the bikes.

Route is:

1. Walker St to Bruce Highway, RIGHT at Bruce H/way and regrouping at truck stop outside the Maryborough Showground.
2. North to Torbanlea, turning RIGHT at Torbanlea (Gympie St), LEFT at Burgowan Road, RIGHT Burrum Heads Rd
3. RIGHT Pialba-Burrum Heads Rd, LEFT at Old Maryborough Rd, LEFT at Tooth St (Regrouping on Tooth St, approx. 15 minutes)
4. LEFT on Martin St and RIGHT at Murphy St, goes into Kelly St, RIGHT on the Esplanade. (Follow through until Elizabeth St)





GOSSIP/RUMOUR

circulating story or report of uncertain or doubtful truth information, often a mixture of truth and untruth, passed around

A rumour, is "a tall tale of explanations of events circulating from person to person and pertaining to an object, event, or issue in public concern." In the social sciences, a rumour involves a form of a statement whose veracity is not quickly or ever confirmed.

GOSSIPER/RUMOUR MONGER

A person who habitually reveals personal or sensational facts about others.

Gossipers are desperate and immature people. They need drama, love conflict and are so deeply unconfident they feel compelled to tell and spread false accusations and stories about others in order to feel a sense of superiority, or to be able to play the ultimate role of the victim

Gossiper - a person given to gossiping and divulging personal information about others. Gossip Monger, News Monger, Rumour Monger, Gossip
