## Bikers thrill kids

MOUNT Isa's 8am rumble was no match for the noise a procession of motorbikes made as it left the city yesterday.

A convoy of about 200 riders from the Southern Cross Association Poker Run took control of Marian Street, waving to onlookers as they started their journey to Townsville.

Earlier this week the group, which has about 400

riders, set the record for the longest continuous line of bikes in the main street of Winton.

The riders spent Wednesday night at Kalkadoon Park entertaining children with bike rides, barbecues and a band.
